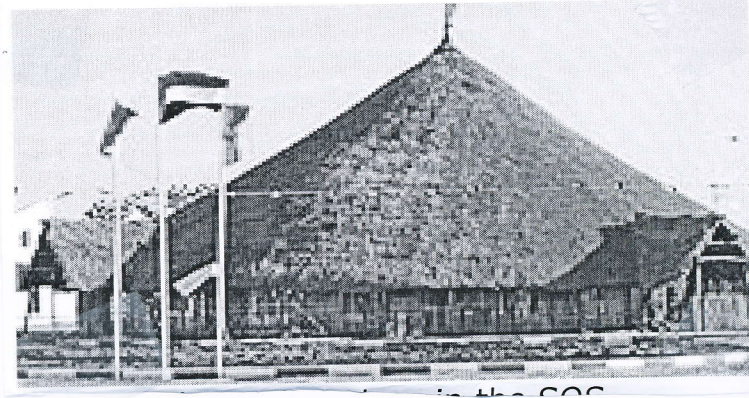


Nyareat Kong
