APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND CHECK LIST

These are the steps and procedures an applicant must successfully complete to become accepted as a Ganassi Racing intern.

_____Phase One: Complete the Application

To be considered for the Ganassi Racing Internship, a student must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a current DMACC Automotive Mechanics Student with a minimum of 30 credits completed or have graduated from a DMACC Automotive program within the last five years.
2. Have a program GPA of at least 2.5 or higher.
3. Have completed the Ganassi Racing Internship Application

_____Phase Two: Attend an Indy Race

- All complete applications will be reviewed by a selection committee made up of judges from Ganassi Racing and DMACC.
- If selected, the applicant must attend a designated Indy race at the Iowa Speedway as a possible candidate for the Ganassi Racing Internship.
- During race day, Ganassi Racing will narrow down their selection to decide who will be interviewed and will move on to the next round. The applicants who are selected will be asked to be present in the pit box with the Pit Crew during the race. Ganassi will determine final selection based on interactions with the candidate in the pit box.

_____Phase Three: Accept the Terms and Conditions of Ganassi Racing Internship

- If chosen as the intern for the Ganassi Racing Internship, the applicant must return the completed Employment Agreement form to the Automotive Program Chair.
- Additionally, the applicant must agree to return to DMACC after the internship has ended to finish their Associate of Applied Science degree in Automotive Mechanics Technology if they have not already done so.

_____Phase Four: Complete the Internship

- The intern will complete an 8 to 10-week internship at the Ganassi Racing Headquarters in Indianapolis, IN.
