The following are also requirements for students majoring in Early Childhood Education:

- **Undergraduates who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or higher at the beginning of their final term are eligible to graduate “with distinction” provided they have completed 60 semester credits of coursework at Iowa State University at the time they graduate, including a minimum of 50 graded credits**
- It is recommended you use the Transfer Equivalency Guide (<http://www.admissions.iastate.edu/equiv/index.php?state=iowa>) or TRANSIT (<https://transit.iastate.edu/>) to make sure Biological & Physical Science, Social Science and Humanities options transfer to ISU and are on the ISU ECE General Education Requirements/Approved Options list <http://www.hdfs.hs.iastate.edu/wp-content/uploads/2014/04/Early-Childhood-Education-approved-options-2014-15-PDF.pdf>
- Meet DMACC distributed requirements of 3 credits in one of the following categories: Humanities, Biological Science or Physical Science.
- One Humanities course must also meet the ISU requirement for International Perspectives, (i.e., HIS 112, FLS 152 or MUS 100).
- DMACC ECE 170, 221, 243, and 343 will transfer into ISU for HD FS 224. All four DMACC classes must be completed before attending ISU to meet the requirements for HD FS 224.
- Students must meet minimum grade of “C” in English 150 (Eng 105) and 250 (Eng 106), and in all professional Education courses in HD FS and C I (this is a requirement for all classes related to teacher education taken at ISU and DMACC-EDU 213 & 245, ECE 170, 221, 243, & 343). Students must obtain a minimum grade of “C-” for the required mathematics class Math 195 (MAT 114).
- DMACC students can choose to take MAT 116 at DMACC or can opt to take at ISU (Math 196) Fall year three (minimum grade C-).
- Maintain at least a 2.50 cumulative GPA at ISU to be in the Teacher Education Program.
- Pass Praxis Core with minimum scores of: Reading-156, Writing-162 and Math-150.
- Fulfill foreign language (flng) requirement of at least two years in High School or 2 semesters of same foreign language in college (will also count towards Humanities credit at ISU).
- The bolded ISU classes must be taken together as a block and in a sequential order.
- Submit to Criminal Background Checks and have no serious charges in this check.
