Please arrive at the Boone Campus Auditorium (Room 112) by 9:00 a.m. on May 6. Staff will assist you in finding your place in the procession and give you instructions for the ceremony. Security is not available for items of value. Please consider leaving these items with family or friends.

Attire: Graduates may wear earned DMACC honor cords, Veteran's cords, Phi Theta Kappa stoles, and Honors medallions at the ceremony. Any additional adornments are prohibited.

Phi Theta Kappa: If you are a PTK member, it is required that you contact Nancy Woods (Room 224, nawoods@dmacc.edu, 515-433-5061) to let her know if you want to wear a PTK stole at graduation.

Honor Cords: To earn an honor cord, students must achieve a 3.50 overall GPA in the courses that apply toward their program of study. Spring 2022 grades are recorded after graduation, so only courses completed through Fall 2021 are included in GPA calculations.

Veteran Cords: Veterans of the United States Armed Services will receive a Veteran's Cord.

Guest Seating: Ample seating is available in the DMACC Boone Campus gymnasium. There will be special seating available for people who need accommodations, and the ceremony will include closed captioning. Diploma Covers: At graduation you will receive a diploma cover. Because final grades are still being recorded after May 6, diplomas are not distributed at commencement. The DMACC Credentials Office in Ankeny will mail diplomas approximately 6 weeks after graduation. NOTE: Students with an outstanding debt to the college will not receive their diploma(s) until all debts are paid in full.
