At-Large Representative Qualifications:

1. Must be an Ankeny Campus Student with at least a 2.00 cumulative GPA.
2. Must be registered in at least six credit hours in fall and spring semester.
3. Must not be under disciplinary action.

Process to Determine Eligibility

1. After application is accepted, student's GPA is reviewed. Minimum GPA required for participation is 2.00 cumulative.
2. FERPA waivers are sent to the Ankeny Judicial Officer and a judicial background is reviewed.
3. Advisor will alert applicant if there are any unmet requirements.

Ankeny SAC Judicial Review Statement

“Students are found ineligible for participation in the Ankeny Campus Student Activities Council (SAC) if one or more of the following is true:

1. If student has accepted responsibility or is found responsible for more than one academic misconduct.
2. If student is found responsible for violation of the DMACC Student Code of Conduct during anytime of their enrollment at DMACC.

Students who are initially found ineligible have the right to appeal the decision within three (3) business days of notice. Students may appeal by email Student Life at studentinvolvement@dmacc.edu. A decision regarding the appeal will be made within three (3) business days of the appeal hearing.” A Review or Appeal Conference will then be set as soon as all parties are able to do so in order for the student to present their statements which they feel support their reasons for their Appeal. A decision will be sent via the student's DMACC email account within 3 business days from the date of the hearing/Review/ Appeal Conference. This decision will be the final decision of the matter.
