

TEAS Online Testing Instructions

Greetings!

Due to the current closure of DMACC to the public, we are implementing remote TEAS testing in order to help you complete your DMACC pre-admission requirements in a timely manner. ATI TEAS has partnered with Proctorio to virtually proctor your assessment. In order for you to test, you **will** need a **desktop or laptop computer with a microphone and webcam, as well as Google Chrome installed**. Please see the specific technical requirements below.

Purpose

ATI is partnering with Proctorio to virtually proctor assessments. Proctorio is a remote proctoring platform that uses machine learning to proctor students from wherever they may be. Proctorio offers a variety of secure exam settings including video, audio, and screen recording designed to maintain the integrity of the assessment and ensure uncompromised exam results.

Technical requirements

A full list of ATI's technical requirements can be found at atitesting.com/technical-requirements.

- Microphone: Any microphone, either internal or external
- Webcam: 320x240 VGA resolution (minimum) internal or external
- Proctorio Google Chrome extension will need to be installed on the desktop or laptop computer (No iPads, tablets or phones are to be used)

The test will be exactly the same as the one you would have taken in a DMACC Testing Center. The only difference is that in addition to a DMACC proctor monitoring your test, the Proctorio software will be running in the background for added security.

If you meet these technical requirements and would like to take the TEAS assessment, please schedule an appointment with a DMACC proctor by following this link <https://calendly.com/dmacctesting/teas-assessment>. Allow 15-20 minutes for the dry run where your computer is set up with the Proctorio software, and an additional 4 hours for check-in and the TEAS assessment. Choose one time slot to **BEGIN** your dry run and test. Once you schedule your appointment, you will receive further instructions.
