## Medical Assistant Program Goals:

- To prepare competent entry-level medical assistants in the cognitive (knowledge), psychomotor (skills), and affective (behavior) learning domains.
- To provide academic assessment of critical thinking, effective communication, and personal responsibility.
- To serve the needs of all communities of interest through continuous program assessment and improvement while monitoring the ever changing health-care environment
- To encourage graduates to become life-long learners through educational activities that keep knowledge and skills current.
- To meet or exceed all Medical Assisting Education Review Board (MAERB)
  established thresholds for outcome assessment in medical assisting programs
  accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education
  Programs (CAAHEP). These include the following DMACC Outcomes:
  - Psychomotor and Affective Domain Objectives Participation Rate (evaluation completed for each graduate on all psychomotor and affective domain objectives) of 100%.
  - Psychomotor and Affective Domain Objectives Success Rate
     (graduates have successfully completed all of the psychomotor
     and affective domain objectives, meeting the cut (passing) score
     established by the program as a minimum standard to be met) of
     100%.

- o Program Retention Rate ≥70%.
- Practicum Evaluation of Students Participation Rate (practicum evaluation completed on applicable cognitive, psychomotor, and affective skills performed during practicum) of 100%.
- Positive Job Placement Rate (graduates who have a position in medical assisting or a related field, are continuing their education, and/or are in the military) ≥ 95%
- National Credentialing Success Rate (CMA ( AAMA)) of graduates)
  ≥ 98%
- O Graduate Survey Participation Rate (graduates returning survey)
  ≥70%
- <u>Graduate Satisfaction Success Rate</u> (satisfactory rating concerning the program given by graduates on MAERB Survey questions)
   ≥ 99%
- Employer Survey Participation Rate (employers returning survey)
  ≥ 60%
- Employer Satisfaction Success Rate (employers returning survey reporting satisfaction with the graduates of the program on MAERB Survey questions) ≥ 99%
