PIE: Author's General Purposes

- **To persuade**: change opinions or take action
 - + Appeal to emotions or intellect
 - + Sources: political texts, editorials
- + To inform: give knowledge, teach
 - + Objective, unemotional
 - + Sources: encyclopedias, research studies, newspapers

- + To express: use language in an expressive, emotional way
 - + To entertain: be humorous or tell a story
 - + Appeal to imagination and sense of humor; use sarcasm, overstate, or understate
 - + Sources: fiction or non-fiction
 - + To inspire/commemorate
 - + Appeal to audience's shared values
 - + Sources: eulogies, Presidential speeches after tragedies, award recipients, graduation ceremonies
- + You might have a combination, but one is usually primary: check (1) the main idea, (2) the source, and (3) the language
